

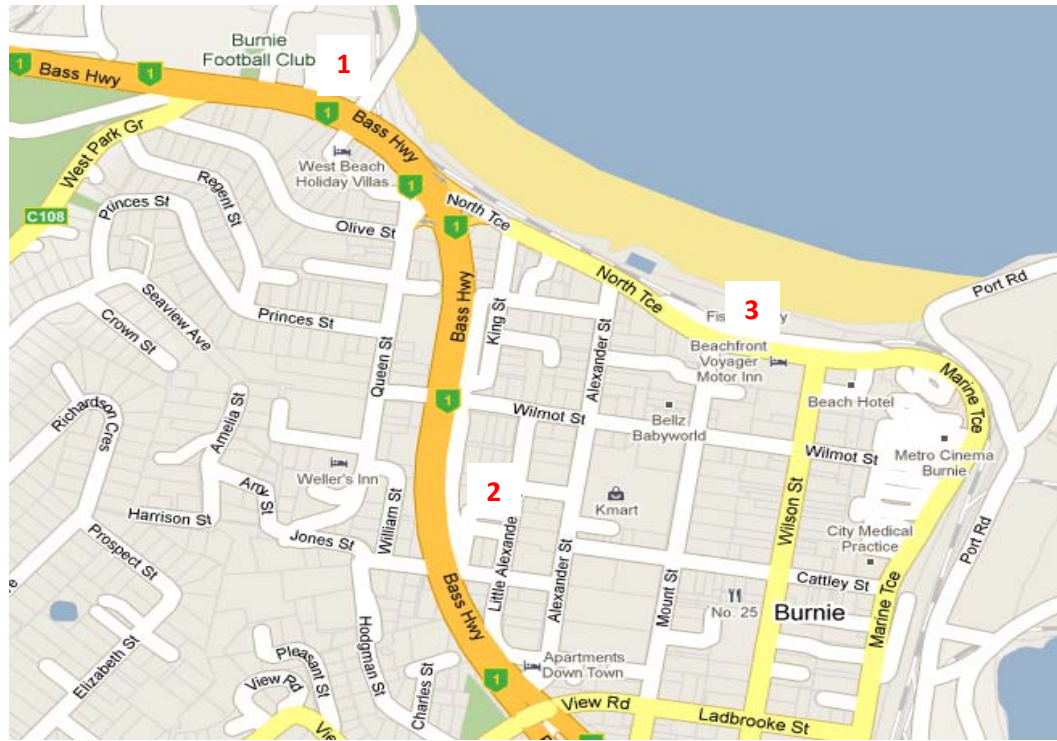


Burnie - City of Makers:

Burnie is known as the city of makers, known for fine craftsmanship and creativity. One of Burnie's newest attractions is the Makers Workshop, and well worth a visit to, to see the makers in action. They have a great little café here for a morning toasted sandwich and coffee is so inclined!

Pop into the Burnie Regional Art Gallery, where you will be presented with the North West Coast's finest art. Exhibitions are constantly changing, and well worth a visit.

If you are feeling a bit peckish, head over to Bayviews Restaurant, right on the beach front for a magnificent back drop to your lunch. Choose either the cheap and cheerful fish frenzy or dine upstairs at Bayviews for the finest in local produce.

After lunch head down Bass Hwy and turn off at Old Surrey Road. On this road you will find more makers- of fine cheeses and whisky! Nearby is the fernglade park, a little hidden green treasure and definitely worth buying some fresh bread, cheese and a good bottle of wine to stop off for a little picnic or afternoon tea! (Great bakery and deli called Delish a bit further down the road to buy picnic provisions. Head back to Bass Hwy and turn right-head to Wivenhoe)
