What I love to do in the Wynyard Area

If you have access to wheels, it is an absolute must to go for a drive along the coast. The views are spectacular, and the landscape varied and interesting. From fields of tulips or poppies, to happy cows in lush green paddocks with the blue waters of bass strait as their back drop.

Go grab your keys, and get in your car and take a drive into town and head towards the lighthouse along saunders street. This will take you up to the cape where you have the lighthouse and the look out to stop and enjoy the vistas. As you are coming back from the lookout take the Tollymore road. This will sweep you along the top of the cape to some amazing views up to Stanley. This road will connect with the main Bass Hwy, so turn right and head on to boat harbour beach.

The azure waters and blindingly white sand are all magical features of this little nook. Stop here for a coffee or light lunch at Jolly Rogers café on the beach-soak in some beach atmosphere. Head back up the road and turn right to Sisters Beach. This is a magnificent long beach with lovely picnic areas nearby. Access to the beach is via the dunes, so not great if you are on personal wheels!

Head back to Wynyard, only 25 minutes away.
